OER. 10 educational interactive games, 5 methods tutorials, 10 e-tools for outcome and satisfaction assessment, 20 self- learning tools will be generated .

Tools. A Virtual platform, the Community of Practice and PLEFs (Personal Learning Environment Frameworks) will be available online as OER.

Guidelines for policy makers as a key element to unlock the potential of OER for a wide up-/re-skilling of heritage and culture tourism professionals.

The **Green Book** will explore and suggest integration possibilities among different funds (ESF, EARDF, Grant Foundations, Challenges).

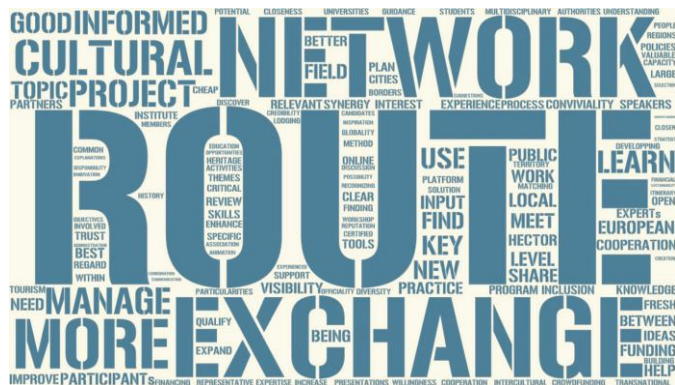

Project

HECTOR project is funded by the programme **Erasmus+, Key Action 2** - Cooperation for innovation and exchange of good practices. This action aims at supporting the development, sharing and transfer of best practices and innovative approaches in the fields of education, training and youth. Central theme, the role of Cultural Routes of the Council of Europe as laboratories for testing new integrated methodologies of formal and non-formal training.

HECTOR initiative aims at comparing practices and developing models to forecast the skills needs in cultural management related professions, as well as at designing, implementing and supporting effective coordination between the world of formal and not formal training (Universities, research centers, vocational institutions and organisations active in cultural heritage promotion).

Objectives

HECTOR project is structured around a coherent set of dedicated and operational objectives:

- 01.** Identifying emerging “hard” and “soft” skill set, related to the new challenges addressing Heritage Management in Europe.
- 02.** Validate a cross-country and cross-sectoral methodology for participatory need analysis in order to better cope the learning outcome and the teaching methods to dynamic re/up-skilling requirements.
- 03.** Integrate MOOC solutions involving both academic and professional sector in order to generate a permanent open repository for innovative self- training and self-assessment.
- 04.** Test peer-to-peer training and skills evaluation, by generating software-based tool.
- 05.** Consolidate a common understanding on how to mix not-formal and formal learning in order to upgrade the competencies of heritage professionals.
- 06.** Create a Virtual Learning Hub for Heritage and Cultural Tourism based on the valorisation of the resources of the 32 Cultural Routes certified by the Council of Europe.
